**Application Overview** 

- Partner institution sends nomination email including student name, email, length
  of exchange (1 or 2 semesters), date of birth, and student type (tuition exchange vs.
  self-pay) to isso-exchange@uncc.edu
- Student receives an email to complete electronic application and submit supporting documents including:
  - Passport biographical page
  - · University transcript in English (include courses in progress)
  - Proof of financial support
  - Proof of English proficiency (if required)
- 3. Once admitted, UNC Charlotte emails the J1 exchange student immigration document (DS-2019) and acceptance letter to exchange student

Once admitted, students will receive an acceptance letter along with an electronic DS-2019. Using the two documents, students will need to complete the following:

- Pay the J1 SEVIS Fee
- Complete form DS-160: Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application
- Locate your nearest U.S. Embassy. Follow the embassy's website instructions for obtaining a Non-Immigrant J1 Exchange Student Visa

#### **Accommodation**

Students are eligible to apply for on-campus housing after they have been admitted. Students will be emailed further instructions upon admission.

#### Airport Transportation

We offer airport pickups on one day only (the day on-campus housing opens). We are able to pick up students from Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT). Students will receive instructions regarding airport pickup once they are admitted.

#### **Course Registration**

UNC Charlotte Course Wish List: During the application process, students will submit their desired courses for the upcoming semester.

Most courses in the university catalogue are only offered one semester per academic year. Use the instructions below when selecting your courses:

Courses Offered – by Semester

Go to Banner Self Service (https://selfservice.uncc.edu), select "Class Schedule," choose the upcoming term (Fall 2025 or Spring 2026) then click "Submit." Choose the subject you are searching for in the "Subject:" box. Then scroll to the bottom of the screen and click "Class Search." (Note - you can only search for one subject at a time.)

Predicting courses to be offered in a future term: If the semester list isn't yet available, you can "guess" what may be offered for an upcoming term (ex. Fall 2025) by reviewing courses that were offered the same term the previous year (ex. Fall 2024).

Course Load Per Semester Undergraduate students: between 12 – 18 credits per semester

Graduate students: between 9 – 12 credits per semester

1 lecture credit = 750 minutes of face-to-face instruction per semester

1 laboratory credit = 1500 minutes of face-to-face instruction per semester

#### **UNC Charlotte Mandatory Health Insurance**
