	As soon as you can & before Nov 1	<p><i>APPLY FOR CAMPUS HOUSING</i></p> <p>Housing & Residence Life provides instructions for Applying for On-Campus Housing. This process charges a non-refundable \$100 application fee. When you are ready to apply, keep these tips in mind:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Login - You'll need to login using your NinerNet credentials (your UNC Charlotte email address and password). • Browser problems - If the application doesn't seem to work, then try a different browser. • Contract – Read the housing contract carefully. You are responsible for observing all important contract dates. • Questions - Have housing questions? Email Housing and Residence Life directly (hrlmailbox@uncc.edu) be sure to include your name, student ID number, and a description of the problem. <p><i>Apply early for your best chance of obtaining an open space. 	As soon as you can & before Nov 1	<p><i>GLOBAL GATEWAYS/GLOBAL LIVING ON CAMPUS (optional, space is limited)</i></p> <p>Global Gateways is an interactive residential program for learning about the world with other international and U.S. students. Read more about Global Gateways. PRIORITY is given to EARLY APPLICATIONS.</p>
	As soon as you can	<p><i>SCHEDULE J-1 VISA APPOINTMENT</i></p> <p>ISEP Students – ISEP, your J-1 visa sponsor, will provide you with visa instructions</p> <p>Non-ISEP Students - The visa status you will have while in the U.S. is J-1. Use your UNC Charlotte issued immigration document DS-2019 to apply for your J-1 visa and as a travel document when entering the U.S.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Pay Your \$220 SEVIS fee - https://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/ 2) Complete form DS-160: Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application 3) Schedule your visa appointment, refer to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate website where you will be interviewed for specific instructions. 	Oct 1 – 31	<p><i>COURSE "WISH LIST"</i></p> <p>Login to the Exchange Student Course Wish List (through the ISSO Connect portal) using your UNC Charlotte email address and password. The form provides instructions for looking up courses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sept 30: UNC Charlotte Spring 2025 course list is published Nov 1: We close the wish list and start requesting your classes Early December: Our advising team shares your course schedule with you
	You may finalize upon arrival	<p><i>FOOD ON CAMPUS</i></p> <p>If you live on-campus you may be automatically assigned a meal plan. Meal plans are optional for students living in on-campus apartments with a kitchen. Even if you are automatically assigned a meal plan, you may still change to a larger meal plan. Read more about the meal plan options. You may finalize your meal plan after you arrive at UNC Charlotte.</p> <p>Meal plan change deadlines – If you need to make changes to your meal plan, pay attention to the following meal plan deadlines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deadline to change without a \$25 administrative fee Last date to make changes
	Dec 5	<p><i>(Optional) REQUEST TEMPORARY HOUSING WITH A LOCAL FAMILY (Jan 5th or Jan 6th ONLY)</i></p> <p>If you need to arrive 1 or 2 days early before on-campus housing opens, complete the temporary home stay form and we will try to place you with a local family for 1 or 2 nights (Only complete one form, either the Jan 7th airport pick up request or the Jan 5th and 6th temporary home stay request).</p>
	Dec 5	<p><i>REQUEST AIRPORT PICKUP FOR ARRIVAL ON JANUARY 7th</i></p> <p>The ISSO can arrange to pick you up from the airport if you arrive January 7th. This is also the date on-campus housing opens for the semester. Let ISSO know if you need to be picked up from the airport (CLT) on January 7th between 8 am – 8 pm. The ISSO provides airport pick-up on this day free of charge.</p>
	Dec 14	<p><i>Earliest date you may enter the U.S. with a Jan 13, 2024, DS-2019 start date</i></p> <p>(You may enter up to 30 days before DS-2019 start date)</p>
	Dec 11	<p><i>UPLOAD STUDENT ID CARD PHOTO</i></p> <p>Don't take a chance on a disappointing ID card photo, instead submit your photo before you arrive. By uploading your photo, your ID card will be created for you before you arrive, which will make it easier for you to enter your building and use your meal plan.</p>

	Dec 18	<p><i>HEALTH INSURANCE – PURCHASE OR OPT OUT (Waive)</i></p> <p>You will be automatically billed for the university’s premium health insurance plan (~\$1500/semester) unless you provide evidence of a comparable plan that provides coverage in the U.S. Read more about insurance requirements and the waiver process.</p> <p><i>Need help with insurance?</i></p> <p>Do you need help waiving or enrolling in insurance? Or do you need confirmation that you waived or enrolled correctly? Contact the Student Health Center. Details below:</p> <p>By phone: 1-704-687-7435 (8 am – 5 pm) By Email: myinsurance@uncc.edu In Person: Go to the Student Health Center, Insurance Office (Campus Map).</p>
	Jan 7 Beginning at 1:00 pm	<p><i>RESIDENCE HALL MOVE-IN (this is an ‘early’ move-in specific for exchange students)</i></p> <p>You will receive specific move-in instructions closer to your arrival date.</p> <p>What to bring: Remember, you must provide your own towels, sheets (54 X 80 in or 150 cm X 200 cm), a blanket and pillow. If you hope to buy these items after you arrive, prepare a back-up plan for the first few nights in case you can’t go shopping for several days.</p>
	Jan 9	<p><i>INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION & DOCUMENT CHECK-IN</i></p> <p>All international students are required to participate in international student orientation. Additional details will be posted on the ISSO Orientation webpage, including sessions specifically for international exchange students.</p>
	Anytime through Jan 13	<p><i>UPLOAD PROOF OF IMMUNIZATIONS</i></p> <p>North Carolina state law requires all college students to submit proof of the required immunizations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • List of Required vaccines – Available from the Student Health Center Immunization Requirements page <p>Upload Proof of vaccines - See FAQs instructions on submitting your immunization records.</p>
	Jan 13	FIRST DAY OF CLASS
	Jan 20	Martin Luther King Jr. Day (no classes)
	Jan 21	<i>Last Day to Change Classes</i>
	Jan 21	<p><i>PAY UNC CHARLOTTE BILLS</i></p> <p>By this date, you must enroll in a payment plan or pay your UNC Charlotte bill in full. Your bill may include: tuition (if it is not covered by a tuition exchange), on-campus housing, meal plan, and any other semester charges. View your e-bill and pay your charges through My UNC Charlotte.</p>

		As exchange students, you are given special permission to pay your bill after you arrive at UNC Charlotte. This is true even though there is an earlier deadline listed for all students (you may receive emails with the earlier deadline—you can ignore those).
	Mar 3 – Mar 8	<i>Spring Break (no class)</i>
	Apr 4 – Apr 5	<i>Refresh Weekend (no class)</i>
	Apr 30	<i>Last Day of Classes</i>
	May 2 – May 8	<i>Final Examinations</i>
	May 9	<i>Campus Housing Closes</i> All students must move out of on-campus housing by this date.
	Jun 30	<i>Last date students with a May 31, 2025 DS-2019 end date may remain in the U.S.</i> You must leave the U.S. no later than 30 days after your DS-2019 end date.
