	As soon as you can & before May 1	<p><b>APPLY FOR CAMPUS HOUSING</b></p> <p>Housing &amp; Residence Life provides instructions for <a href="#">Applying for On-Campus Housing</a>. This process charges a non-refundable \$100 application fee. When you are ready to apply, keep these tips in mind:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Login</b> - You'll need to login using your NinerNet credentials (your UNC Charlotte email address and password).</li> <li>• <b>Browser problems</b> - If the application doesn't seem to work, then try a different browser.</li> <li>• <b>Contract</b> – Read the housing contract carefully. You are responsible for observing all important contract dates.</li> <li>• <b>Questions</b> - Have housing questions? Email Housing and Residence Life directly (<a href="mailto:hrmailbox@charlotte.edu">hrmailbox@charlotte.edu</a>) be sure to include your name, student ID number, and a description of the problem.</li> </ul> <p><i>Apply early for your best chance of obtaining an open space. 	As soon as you can & before April 6	<p><b>GLOBAL GATEWAYS/GLOBAL LIVING ON CAMPUS (optional, space is limited)</b></p> <p>Global Gateways is an interactive residential program for learning about the world with other international and U.S. students. Read more about <a href="#">Global Gateways</a>. <b>PRIORITY is given to EARLY APPLICATIONS.</b></p>
	As soon as you can	<p><b>SCHEDULE J-1 VISA APPOINTMENT</b></p> <p><b>ISEP Students</b> – ISEP, your J-1 visa sponsor, will provide you with visa instructions</p> <p><b>Non-ISEP Students</b> - The visa status you will have while in the U.S. is J-1. Use your UNC Charlotte issued immigration document DS-2019 to apply for your J-1 visa and as a travel document when entering the U.S.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Pay Your \$220 SEVIS fee - <a href="https://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/">https://www.fmjfee.com/i901fee/</a></li> <li>2) Complete form <a href="#">DS-160: Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application</a></li> <li>3) Schedule your visa appointment, refer to the <a href="#">U.S. Embassy or Consulate website</a> where you will be interviewed for specific instructions. This process charges a fee.</li> </ol> <p>Documents to bring to the interview:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DS-2019</li> <li>• Letter of acceptance to UNC Charlotte</li> <li>• Proof of financial support</li> <li>• Evidence that you have paid the SEVIS fee</li> </ul>

	March 3 – 31	<p><i>COURSE "WISH LIST"</i></p> <p>Login to the <a href="#">Exchange Student Course Wish List</a> (through the ISSO Portal under “) using your UNC Charlotte email address and password. The form provides instructions for looking up courses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>March 3:</b> UNC Charlotte Fall 2025 course list is published</li> <li>• <b>March 31:</b> We close the wish list and start requesting your classes</li> <li>• <b>Early May:</b> Our advising team shares your course schedule with you</li> </ul>
	You may finalize upon arrival	<p><i>FOOD ON CAMPUS</i></p> <p>If you live on-campus you may be automatically assigned a meal plan. Meal plans are optional for students living in on-campus apartments with a kitchen. Even if you are automatically assigned a meal plan, you may still change to a larger meal plan. Read more about the <a href="#">meal plan options</a>. You may finalize your meal plan after you arrive at UNC Charlotte.</p> <p><b>Meal plan change deadlines</b> – If you need to make changes to your meal plan, pay attention to the following <a href="#">meal plan deadlines</a>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline to change without a \$25 administrative fee</li> <li>• Last date to make changes</li> </ul>
	July 25	<p><i>(Optional) REQUEST TEMPORARY HOUSING WITH A LOCAL FAMILY (up to 2 nights, Aug 8 &amp; 9)</i></p> <p>If you need to arrive 1 or 2 days early before on-campus housing opens, complete the <a href="#">temporary home stay form</a> and we will try to place you with a local family for 1 or 2 nights, Aug 8 &amp; 9 (Only complete one form, either the airport pick up request for Aug 10 or the temporary home stay request for Aug 8 &amp; 9).</p>
	July 25	<p><i>(Optional) REQUEST AIRPORT PICKUP FOR ARRIVAL ON Aug 10th</i></p> <p>The ISSO can arrange to pick you up from the airport if you arrive on Aug 10, the official move-in date for exchange students. Let ISSO know if you need to <a href="#">be picked up from the airport (CLT) on Aug 10</a> between 8 am – 8 pm. The ISSO provides airport pick-up free of charge.</p>
	July 19	<p><i>EARLIEST DATE YOU MAY ENTER THE U.S. with an August 18th, DS-2019 start date</i></p> <p>(You may enter up to 30 days before DS-2019 start date)</p>
	Aug 1	<p><i>HEALTH INSURANCE – PURCHASE OR OPT OUT (Waive)</i></p> <p>You will be automatically billed for the university's premium health insurance plan (<b>\$1475/semester</b>) unless you provide evidence of a comparable plan that provides coverage in the U.S. <a href="#">Read more about insurance requirements and waiver process.</a></p> <p><i>Need help with insurance?</i></p> <p>Need Help? 	Aug 1	<p><b>UPLOAD ID PHOTO &amp; ACTIVATE YOUR 49ER MOBILE ID</b></p> <p>Upload your photo and activate your <a href="#">49er Mobile ID</a>. By setting up your electronic ID before you arrive, it will be easier for you to enter your building and use your meal plan on your first day on campus.</p>
	Aug 10 Beginning at 1:00 pm	<p><b>RESIDENCE HALL MOVE-IN (this is an 'early' move-in specific for exchange students)</b></p> <p>You will receive specific move-in instructions closer to your arrival date.</p> <p><b>What to bring:</b> Remember, you must provide your own towels, sheets (54 X 80 in or 150 cm X 200 cm), a blanket and pillow. If you hope to buy these items after you arrive, prepare a back-up plan for the first few nights in case you can't go shopping for several days.</p>
	Aug 13	<p><b>INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION &amp; DOCUMENT CHECK-IN</b></p> <p>All international students are required to participate in international student orientation. Additional details will be posted on the <a href="#">ISSO Orientation webpage</a>, including sessions specifically for international exchange students.</p>
	Anytime through Aug 18	<p><b>UPLOAD PROOF OF IMMUNIZATIONS</b></p> <p>North Carolina state law requires all college students to submit proof of the required immunizations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>List of Required vaccines</b> – Available from the Student Health Center <a href="#">Immunization Requirements page</a></li> </ul> <p><b>Upload Proof of vaccines</b> - See <a href="#">FAQs</a> instructions on submitting your immunization records.</p>
	Aug 18	FIRST DAY OF CLASS
	Aug 29	<p><b>NINER COURSE PACK – LAST DAY TO OPT OUT</b></p> <p>Check out these <a href="#">resources to help you decide if the Niner Course Pack is right for you</a>. Read more on the <a href="#">Niner Course Pack webpage</a>.</p>
	Sep 1	LABOR DAY (NO CLASSES)
	Aug 25	<i>Last Day to Change Classes</i>
	Aug 26	<p><b>PAY UNC CHARLOTTE BILLS</b></p> <p>By this date, you must <a href="#">enroll in a payment plan</a> or pay your UNC Charlotte bill in full. Your bill may include: tuition (if it is not covered by a tuition exchange), on-campus housing, meal plan, and any other semester charges. View your e-bill and pay your charges through <a href="#">My UNC Charlotte</a>.</p> <p><i>As exchange students, you are given special permission to pay your bill after you arrive at UNC Charlotte. This is true even though there is an earlier deadline listed for all students.</i></p>
	Oct 9 - 10	<b>FALL BREAK (NO CLASS)</b>

	Nov 26 - 29	<i>THANKSGIVING BREAK (NO CLASS)</i>
	Dec 2	<i>LAST DAY OF CLASSES</i>
	Dec 4 - 10	<i>FINAL EXAMINATIONS</i>
	Dec 11	<i>CAMPUS HOUSING CLOSES</i> All fall semester only students must move out of on-campus housing by this date. Students continuing through the spring semester can continue accessing on-campus housing.
	Jan 30	<i>Last date students with a Dec 31, 2025, DS-2019 end date may remain in the U.S.</i> You must leave the U.S. no later than 30 days after your DS-2019 end date.
