		 Browser problems - If the application doesn't seem to work, then try a different browser while on a Virtual Private Network (VPN). <u>UNC Charlotte has a VPN for students</u>. 	
		 Contract — Read the housing contract carefully. You are responsible for observing all important contract dates.

	Dec 11	Set up your <u>49er Mobile ID</u> and <u>submit your ID photo before you arrive</u> . Your 49er Mobile ID needs to be set up prior to arrival in order for you to easily and immediately access important campus services, including access to your dorm, meal plan, etc.

Dec 17		You will be automatically billed for the university's premium health insurance plan (Per semester rates: Ugrad: \$1583.50; Grad: \$1802.92) unless your sponsor (sending program) mandates that you have a specific plan (e.g. ISEP) and you successfully apply for a waiver out of the university plan. Waiver approval is not guaranteed.
